## LIFETIME LIMITED WARRANTY

NAC takes pride in its standard of craftsmanship and use of high-quality materials. As a measure of our confidence, we extend to you, the original purchaser, a limited warranty that shall remain in effect for as long, as you own your cabinets.

This warranty covers all cabinetry manufactured by NAC and purchased through an authorized NAC dealer. It is tendered to the original consumer and applies only to the repair or replacement of the defective materials at the sole discretion of the manufacturer. NAC is not liable for, and does not cover the removal, shipment of re-installation of said materials, or any accidental damage caused by another person while performing these operations. Replacement of drawer slides and other hardware is covered by the respective warranties of each hardware manufacturer and is subject to the availability from said manufacturer.

This warranty will become void if the product exhibits any sign of abuse, misuse, inappropriate storage or faulty installation of product. As there are many individual characteristics in wood species, the warranty only applies to defects in product and not to the natural aspects of the wood itself, such as movement with temperature and humility, or color changes and cracks due to aging. See ANNEX TO WARRANTY (page 6) for full details of the care that <u>MUST</u> be followed in order to render your warranty valid.

Notice of a claim must be made by the original purchaser. To obtain warranty service, contact the dealership where the cabinetry was purchased. If the dealer cannot be reached, send your concerns to NAC at the address shown at the bottom of this page. No representation of NAC has the authority to expand or modify the above warranty or liability.
